The Charles F. Curry Library serves as the intellectual hub of William Jewell College. Its mission is to afford all students, faculty and staff the ability to find the right information at the right time.

Besides books, print journals and a selection of state and federal documents, the Library is expanding its technological offerings through research databases, electronic books, journals, and modern communications technology.

As a member of the regional Kansas City Metropolitan network and the statewide MOBIUS consortium, Curry Library provides access to works contained in many private and public libraries. We also gain the benefits of sharing resources for computerized purchasing, record keeping and reporting.

Our Special Collections Department houses the College's archives, as well as collections of poetry, children's literature, limited and first editions, fine printing, and religious works. We also host the William E. Partee Center for Baptist Historical Studies, a uniquely extensive collection of papers and important historical material related to the Baptist experience in Missouri.
